- Be able to change the numbers of each item as it is used through out the year


- Continue to upkeep this list, adding and subtracting mediums as we use them.





Although this is not a class project, some brainy bits are involved for the teachers who maintain this inventory:


#### Gardner's Multiple Intelligences:
